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The RL24s, with over 450 afloat in Australia and proving very popular in the U.S.A. are ideal for both cruising and racing. More than anything else, the main requirement of a tralable yacht is that it can be used and sailed well in a wide range of conditions ... it is here that the sheer joy of sailing is achieved.

PERFORMANCE: The RL24 is aclaimed to be one of the fastest trailer sailers in Australia and has a remarkable track record. They have proven their capabilities in all conditions, from light airs of inland waters to rugged coastal waters, and have won most mixed trailer sailer events in past seasons.

ACCOMODATION: Designed to sleep four adults or two adults and three children, the interior of the RL24 has been purposely kept open and clear of unecessary bulkheads and obstructions to give the necessary elbow room for comfortable living. The midship galley and ice box areas are most convenient, and the cabin can be divided if required. Many families have sailed the Barrier Reef and lived aboard for annual holidays.

SAFETY: A lot of thought has gone in to the safety features in the RL24, she has been proven self righting with the centreboard locked down by the Industrial Design Council of Australia, and also by a well known national boating magazine.

A large compartment aft, another up forward, as well as sealed coamings ensures that the boat will float even in the most extreme circumstances. The buoyancy of an RL24 is sufficient to float the boat even if cut in half plus 25%, and is amde up of seven separate water tight compartments. The deep self draining cockpit aft gives great sense of of security, and the unique forward cockpit (also self draining) makes for much safer forward work.

<u>AUXILLIARY POWER</u>: Auxilliary power is provided by an outboard motor shipped through a specially designed well at the after end of the cock-pit ... this method has proven very efficient with little opportunity for cavitation.

Motors with standard length shaft from 4HP to 10HP are recommended.

Although one of the larger trailer sailers, the RL24 is one of the easiest to rig and launch, and requires only 400mm of water under her stern when launching. We <u>NEVER</u> get the axle wet when launching or retrieving.

GOOD DESIGN AWARD: Awarded by the Industrial Design Council of Australia in 1976, the RL24 was the third boat in Australia to achieve this award, and recieved high praise for

The new RL24 Mark 1V model, which is within the RL24 class rules, is proving to be an extremely fast boat, its performance is some 4% better than the Mark 111. This boat features a vertical lift big section keel which is lead filled in the bottom half, a fully battened big roach mainsail, and the option of a new interior with bulkhead and galley to port, and increased sitting room.
