NOTICES OF MOTION FOR THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

RULE 9.1 NUMBER OF SAILS RULE 9.1 STATES - THE NUMBER OF SAILS PER BOAT IS UNRESTRICTED, BUT ONLY ONE MAST AND ONE SUIT OF SAILS TO BE USED DURING RACING IN A STATE OR NATIONAL TITLE SERIES. THE SUIT TO CONSIST OF NO MORE THAN ONE MAIN.

SAIL, TWO HEADSAILS (ONE SUITABLE FOR USE AS A STORM JIB) AND ONE SPINNAKER. THE MOTION IS TO DELETE THE WORDS IN THE BRACKETS (ONE SUITABLE FOR USE AS A STORM JIB) LEAVING THE REST OF THIS CLAUSE AS IS.

2. RULE 7.3 FOAM IN THE TOP OF THE MAST MOTION BY D. PARMENTER THAT THIS CLAUSE BE DELETED. WITH THE ADVENT OF INTERNAL MAIN SAIL HALYARDS THIS RULE CREATES PROBLEMS EVEN THOUGH THIS FOAM IS A ADDED SAFETY GUARD IN THE CASE OF A COMPLETE KNOCKDOWN AND ROLLOVER.
