

THE QUEENSLAND RL24 ASSOCIATION

THE QUELNSLAND RL24 ASSOCIATION WAS REFORMED IN JULY 1987, AND IN 12 MONTHS HAS A BOAT REGISTER OF 32 BOATS. WE HOPE TO ENLARGE ON THIS MORE AS THE ASSOCIATION BICOMES MORE WELL KNOWN.

OUR MAIN OBJECTIVE FOR THE SEASON WAS TO HOLD A SUCCESSFULL STATE TITLES WHICH WE DID AT EASTER 1988, AT LAKE COOTHARABA SAILING CLUB.

16 BOATS COMPETED IN A 5 RACE SERIES WHICH SAW ALL TYPLS OF WEATHER CONDITIONS. WE APPLIED A

HANDICAP SYSTEM TO THE SERIES TO ENDEAVOUR TO MAKE THE RACING COMPETITIVE TO ALL VARIATIONS OF RL24's. WE STARTED WITH THE BASIC RL24 MARK I, WITH A SWING KELL AND SOFT SAIL. THE MANDICAP TIME WAS ADJUSTED FOR EACH! MODIFACATION, SUCH AS DROP KILL, BATTEN MAIN, AND KEVLAR. ALL SKIPPERS AND CREW MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOUR OF THIS SYSTEM, ALLOWING FOR THE FACT THE THESE TIMES WOULD NOW BE MADE MORE ACCURATE WITH THE RACE TIMES THAT WERE AVAILABLE AFTER THE EASTER SIRILS.

USING THIS HANDICAP SYSTEM, THE QUEENSLAND RL24
CHAMPIONSHIP WAS WON BY "KANDYMAN" SKIPPERED BY J.McAULAY, FROM LAKE
COOTHARABA SAILING CLUB. A TROPHY WAS ALSO PRESENTED TO THE FASTIST RL24
IN QUEENSLAND WHICH WAS WON BY "F-TROOP" SKIPPERED BY D.PARMINTER. THE
FASTEST SWING KEEL RL24 IN QUIENSLAND WAS WON BY "AQUILLA" SKIPPERED BY
G.TARRATT.
