

### 1. RHYLL WEEKEND.

## 2. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.

### 3. STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Four heats were scheduled over the 3 day long weekend in January. Two heats were successfully conducted but two heats were blown out and abandoned.

It was decided by concensus among the ten competitors to re-schedule Heat 4 for 2.30 pm on April 7th to provide a meaningful result. After 2 heats Lowana VI and Sasha are level on points with a 1st and 2nd each in division 1, while Anitra is the only contender in division 2. Splice and Liason are also both well placed for trophy honours.

## 1. NATIONAL SCENE.

With the advent of the National Title regatta and AGM, the Australian RL24 affairs are now being administered from N.S.W. - host state for the 1991 championships.

The titles at Noosa were won by a local club boat - CandyMan, with Gladstone entrant F-Troop 2nd and another local, Dumptruck 3rd. Best of the Vics was Liason 5th, Lowana VI, 7th, and Pegasus, 9th. Streetcar was 2nd in Division 2 and Anitra 4th.

There were 20 entries from 3 states.

The 1991 event will be on Lake MacQuarie in January.
