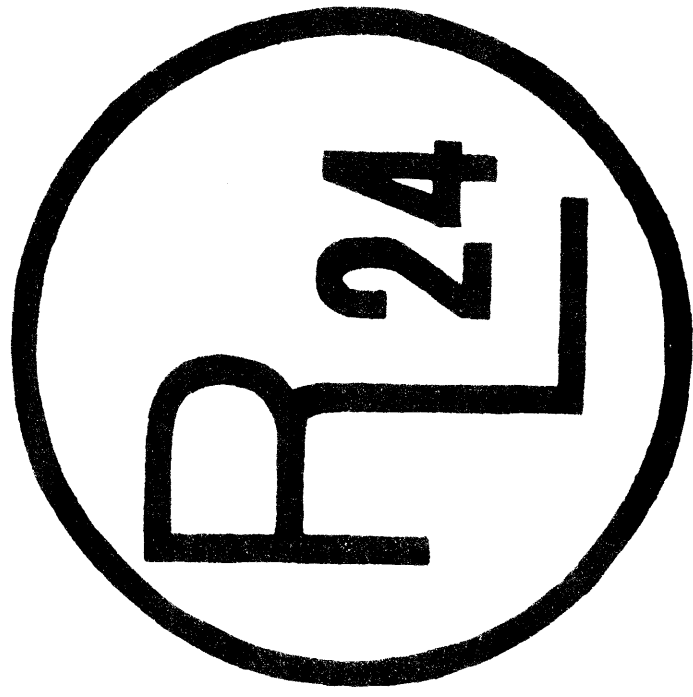
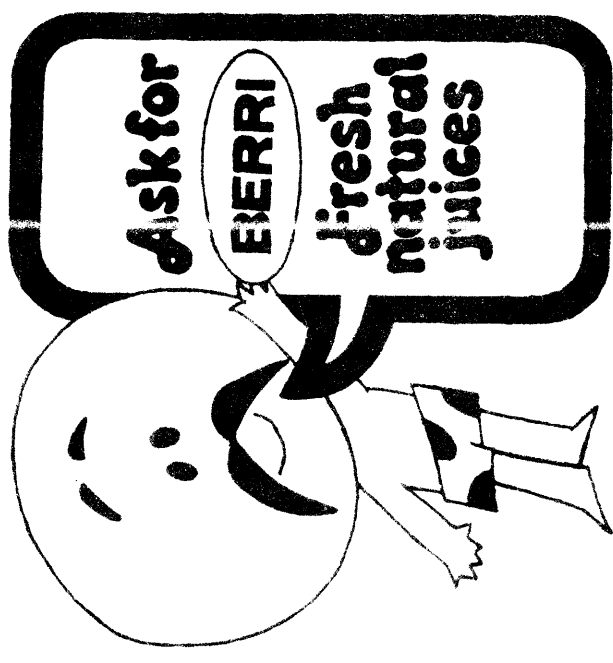

**NOTICE OF RACE.**

1. Rules

All races shall be conducted under the current Racing Rules of the I.Y.R.U., Prescriptions of the A.Y.F., Safety Regulations of the A.Y.F., and the RL24 Class Rules, all as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility

Entries are open to financial members of the RL24 Owners Association of Australia who hold a current measurement form certified by an official class association measurer.

4. Entries

by December 2nd 1977, and accompanied by a fee of \$10.00. Late entries will be accepted up to 9.00 a.m. January 5th 1978, subject to payment of a late entry fee of \$20.00.

5. Sailing Instructions

It is anticipated that Sailing Instructions will be posted to all entries accepted by the Race Committee by December 16th, 1977; further copies will be available at the Regatta Headquarters prior to the first race.

6. Scoring System

The Olympic Scoring system shall be used in accordance with the 1977-81 I.Y.R.U. Rules, Appendix 5 - "Olympic Scoring System".

7. Prize List

Trophies will be awarded on the basis of aggregate points for the series to 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters.

Trophies will also be presented to the winner of each heat.

8. Special Information

Lake Bonney is a fresh water, kidney shaped lake, approximately 9 km by 5 km with an average depth of 5 m. It is free of obstructions, and the sandy shore is excellent for mooring and landing boats. The lake is connected to the River Murray by a navigable creek, offering interesting cruising.

The clubhouse adjoins a motel and a caravan park and is within walking distance of the main shopping area.
