


QLD. RL24 ASSOCIATION

The Queensland RL24 State Titles held over Easter at Lake Cootharaba was a great success to all who attended. 18 boats participated in very competative racing. On both a state and national level 18 entries is successful in its self. At the A.G.M. held on the Friday night several items were discussed. Membership Fees remain the same.

Venue fornext State Titles- Lake Cootharaba . Members are asked to approach other clubs to host 1991 so that venue can be set at 1990 A.G.M.

The Handicap System was discussed in length with the meeting voting to continue with present system with adjustments being made to times so that a fair and accurate handicap system is used to determine the Queensland RL24 Champion.

The National Titles was also discussed. The venue will be Lake Cootharaba with registration on the 29th December and last race on the 7th January, 1990. A preliminary Notice of Race is enclosed. Accommodation details are listed in the Notice of Race. We would like to see as many boats as possible participate, especially the swing keels. If we are to gain acceptance of the Queensland Handicap system we must have the support of the Swing Keel RL24s and what better place to show this support but at the National Titles and the National A.G.M., So lets show that the RL24 Fleet in Queensland is a strong one.
