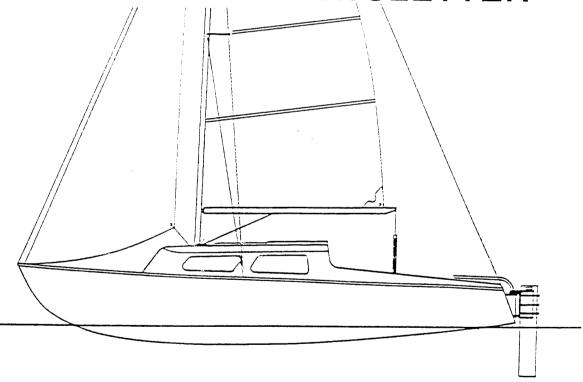

VICTORIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS - LOCH SPORT - 5/6 MARCH 94

MARLEY POINT OVERNIGHT RACE - 12/13 MARCH 94

The RLs had a birthday - and what a party we had! A week of great weather, terrific racing and marvellous social cameraderie were the perfect ingredients for a memorable celebration of 21 years of RL 24s. It all came together at the 21st. RL 24 National Championships held this year at the Mannering Park Amateur Sailing Club located on the southern shores of Lake Macquarie in NSW. With memories still fresh of a great National Championship regatta in 1991, the crews of the 12 RLs who turned up this year in expectation of a similar series were not disappointed. Lake Macquarie is a wonderful place to sail and the MPASC is unsurpassed for friendly hospitality and race management. Led by club Commodore Roy Fredericks (a former RL 24 owner), the Race Committee set excellent courses despite constant harassment from shifting winds and supervised the racing with great competence. The fairly frequent variation in wind strength and direction caused equally frequent spitting of dummies but at least we mostly had breezes and it was warm and sunny throughout - great for sailing. The 6th. heat was actually postponed to the following day due to excessive winds which coincidentally fanned the horrific bushfires we could see across the water to the north. Proceedings began with 3 short triangular races which, in lieu of an Invitation Race, formed the basis of a Personal Handicap system. This was applied across the fleet to establish handicap winners for each heat and an overall handicap winner thus giving all skippers ( not just the hotshots ) a chance to be rewarded for an improvement in their sailing skills. As usual, the championship series consisted of 6 Olympic triangle races and one long distance event. At the end, Simon Walsh (OHAU RUA) and John Wood (STREET CAR) had again demonstrated their superiority in the Drop Keel and Swing Keel divisions, respectively. OHAU RUA was, as usual, crewed magnificently by Darryn Dyer (brother-in-law to Simon), Bert and "Moon" (aka Brude Robinson) while Woody was equally ably assisted by son Stephen, Roger and "Knuckles", a most unkind nickname for a very clever bloke whose proper name is Mark. Congratulations to all concerned with both boats. Although both boats won moderately comfortably (Simon won 7straight!) there were close tussles for the minor places in both divisions. In the Drop Keels, the issue was not resolved until the last heat as a result of which LOWANNA vi (Mick Shannon) was runner-up in the Championship with SLIPPERY WHEN WET (The Troy Boys - Kevin and Brian) third. In the Swing Keel division, STREET CAR was challenged strongly for much of the series by Alex Kostin (MINKIE) who comes from Townsville and Brian Hollingworth (RAGGA LUFFIN) from Mannering Park. However, STREET CAR managed to break clear towards the end but second place went to the wire with RAGGA LUFFIN just getting up. The overall handicap winner was Garry Slater from Colac (Vic.) sailing his swing-keeler LINDY LOU. The COOLIBAH TROPHY, awarded to the best team of three boats from any State was won this year by NSW represented by STREET CAR, RAGGA LUFFIN and SLIPPERY WHEN WET. The TOAD OF BARMERA TROPHY, said by some to be the most prestigious offered by the Association, and awarded for "conclusive consistency" was "won" by COSMIC SEDSO on the basis that for ard hand Bob Tandy was whacked

on the head by the boom on 17 consecutive tacks. Well, it seemed like 17 at the time - might have been 37. We lost count. Around the fleet there were many other meritorious performances which added to the quality of the racing and the general enjoyment of the event. For example, Tony and Jenny Thoms (CRESCENT) sailed every heat just 2-up which kept them very busy indeed. Nevertheless, they thoroughly enjoyed themselves and were good enough to win a heat on handicap. The doyen of NSW RL24 skippers, Viv. Davenport (SEPTEMBER SONG) also raced most of the heats with daughter Jane as the only crew although wife Rae was seen to be press-ganged aboard for the long distance race. Despite the lack of hands, the Davenports had a greaf series and they, too, won a heat on handicap. The Grey-Power Movement, if not the Noise Abatement Society, was rumoured to be well represented aboard BUNYIP with septuagenarian skipper Ron Mc.Crindle ably assisted by Les Brown (owner of RL24 ALLICIA ii), Dave and resident nurse (in case of emergencies), Kate, who must be the most tolerant and overworked drew to ever set foot on an RL24. However, she takes it all with a good grace, her considerable sailing skills being more than adequate to repel the constant barrage of good-natured (?) insults hurled at BUNYIP by certain other (inferior) Victorian crews. For his part, it should be said that Ron, who is a tireless advocate for the class and a great supporter of RL24 events, got BUNYIP to the line 1st. on handicap in at least one heat and did very well in several others. One of the closest of many tussles during the regatta came in the long distance race between PEGASUS (Bruce Castles) and COSMIC SEDSO (Ross Corben) with 4th place being in dispute. At about the halfway point, COSMIC had a handy lead but PEGASUS began its remorseless chase and with just a couple of kilometres to go, she had caught right up, both boats racing side by side under spinnakers. Gradually but irresistibly, PEGASUS forged ahead by about 50 metres but with the line just a hundred metres or so away, COSMIC picked up a fluke breeze and rallied again. Tension soared on both boats as it looked like she might run past PEGASUS but the old war horse from Lake Wellington simply responded as she so often has over the years by finding something extra when it matters. Picking up her skirts, she dashed for the line beating COSMIC by 3 boat-lengths or so after more than 3 hours of exhilarating racing and confirming the excitement to be had from good close class racing. A complete table of the results of each heat and the final placings appears elsewhere in this newsletter. Next year, the circus moves to Rhyll on Victoria's Phillip Island. This, too, is a magnificent sailing venue and our hosts, the Rhyll Yacht Club, is renowned for its hospitality and its capacity to conduct excellent regattas. Without doubt it will be an outstanding series. The Committee hopes you can be there to enjoy it. Finally, a word of thanks and congratulations to John Wood and his committee of Viv. Davenport, Kevin and Brian Troy and Mike Stephens who not only ran the Association so well during the year but organised a marvellous National Championship.
